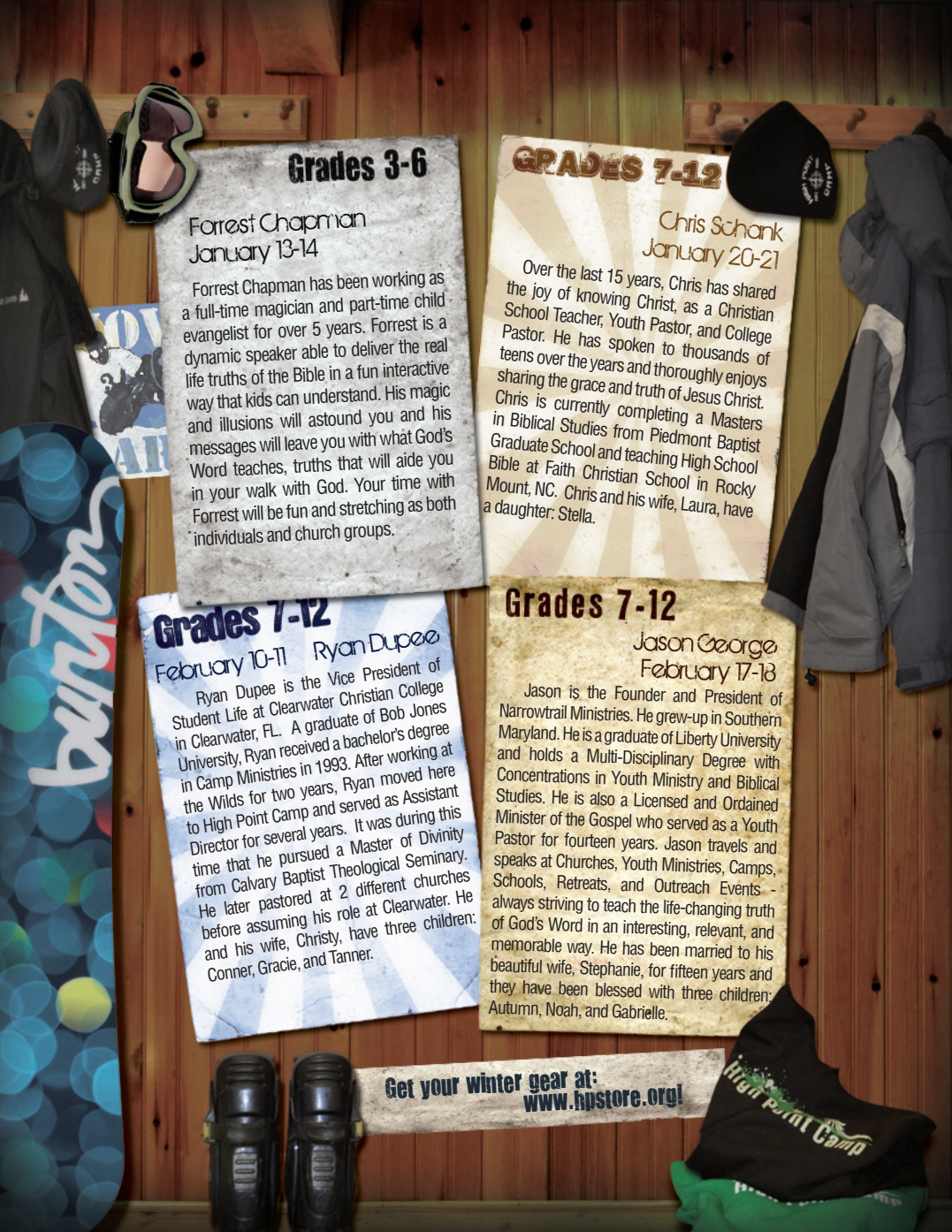

Cost: \$60.00

Please Note: an additional \$10 fee will be added to registrations that are not postmarked at least 10 days before the beginning of the camp. Telephone, fax, and walk-in registrations are NOT accepted, but online registration is available.

What to Bring:

Cell phones, radios, CD players, MP3 players or iPods, knives, cigarettes/tobacco, drugs, alcohol, fireworks, or guns. Non-cooperative or non-compliant campers are subject to dismissal.

Schedule:

Registration is from 5:00 p.m. - 6:30 p.m. No dinner will be served, however, there will be a pizza snack at 9:30 p.m. Camp ends on Saturday at approximately 4:15. Please visit our website for a more detailed schedule.

Activities:

You will have an awesome time with our skis, sports tournaments, crazy games, ping-pong, air hockey, carpet ball, foosball, and snow tubing (weather permitting). Our sports tournaments include volleyball, paintball, 3-on-3 basketball, carpetball, and a Nintendo Wii competition!

Saturday Night Option:

Housing can be made available for church groups on Saturday night for an additional \$15 per person. This will include a Saturday dinner and a continental breakfast on Sunday. Reservations must be made when registering. Groups will be responsible for their own program.

Counselors and Housing:

Churches are to bring one adult for every 8-10 campers. If possible, bring both male and female leaders if bringing mixed campers. One adult attends free for every 10 campers registered (this would not include Saturday night stay). Group leaders will be housed with their group and possibly other individual campers. Leaders must register as well as campers. Cabin requests cannot be guaranteed.
